Provides financial assistance toward the development/maintenance of Elite Table Tennis athletes in Alberta.

Based on disbursement on two (2) Silver Card awards (\$500.00 each).

Silver cards will be distributed to the top athletes based on team trial and tournament results.

Application Deadline: August 1, 2008

Applications will be reviewed by the Executive Committee and will be awarded by August 31, 2008.

Objective:

- ◆ To increase and maintain the number of Alberta Table Tennis athletes named to the National Team.

Eligibility:

Candidates must:

- ✓ Be a Canadian Citizen or have landed immigrant status.
- ✓ Be a resident of Alberta for a minimum of one (1) year prior to selection.
- ✓ Compete in Alberta throughout the period of the Grant
- ✓ Be currently active in tournaments and training throughout the previous season and be a member of the ATTA in good standing.
- ✓ Be named to the National Table Tennis Squad in any capacity
- ✓ Recipient must display good sportsmanship on and off the court.
- ✓ Recipient agrees to represent Alberta at competitions where required, meeting all competition eligibility.

Selection Criteria:

Recipients will be determined according to the tournament and team trial results. Gold cards will be awarded to the top athletes.

Must qualify for the Canadian Senior Team.

Application Process:

- ✓ Applications must be submitted to the ATTA office no later than August 1st of the current year.
- ✓ Recipient must submit a Training Plan detailing past accomplishments and future training plans with each application.

To receive funding:

In order to receive AADP funding:

- ✓ You must meet all of the selection criteria established by the ATTA with no exceptions; incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- ✓ You must submit a training plan. Training plans should provide information on skill training, fitness training, goals as well as an evaluation of the previous season. Completed of training plans will be used to determine future grant eligibility.
- ✓ Receipts must be detailed and submitted on the expense page provided with application. Funding will be paid out based on the receipts provided up to the maximum amount \$1000.00

- ◆ To increase and maintain the number of Alberta Table Tennis athletes named to the National Team.

Eligibility:

Candidates must:

- ✓ Be a Canadian Citizen or have landed immigrant status.
- ✓ Be a resident of Alberta for a minimum of one (1) year prior to selection.
- ✓ Compete in Alberta throughout the period of the grant.
- ✓ Be currently active in tournaments and training throughout the previous season and be a member of the ATTA in good standing.
- ✓ Be named to the National Table Tennis Squad in any capacity.
- ✓ Recipient must display good sportsmanship on and off the court.
- ✓ Recipient agrees to represent Alberta at competitions where required, meeting all competition eligibility.

Silver Cards will be awarded to Junior (18 and under) athletes.

Silver card recipients will be determined according to the tournament and team trial results.
